Memo of Understanding between South Hadley Public Schools and The South Hadley Education Association.

Both parties agree to the following pending ratification by both parties.

** Per the signed Memorandum of Understanding dated December 14, 2021, the South Hadley Public Schools and The South Hadley Education Association agreed to half days for high school students and high school teachers on Saturday, December 18, 2021, and Good Friday, April 15, 2021, by attending the full-day district wide professional development on April 12, 2022.*


Friday, April 15, 2022 - Good Friday (half day)*



The rationale for this modification:

- The Saturday dates will be half days for students and full days for staff members.
- This spreading out of days provides alignment of vacation days throughout the district.
- Using February break as an opportunity to extend the time staff and students are not interfacing.
