Description and General Statement of Intent THE SMITH EDUCATIONAL FUND

South Hadley, Massachusetts

The Smith Educational Fund is a perpetual trust fund established by the will of Miss Jennie W. Smith. It was given in memory of Mr. Ellis R. Smith who died in 1943 and Miss Jennie W. Smith, who died in 1952, both being lifelong residents of South Hadley. The Trustee is Bank of America of Springfield, Massachusetts.

The purpose of the trust is to assist worthwhile boys and girls residing in the Town of South Hadley, Massachusetts, desirous of procuring a higher education to prepare and train them for a trade or profession. The Trustee shall hold, manage, invest and re-invest the trust fund in perpetuity and pay or apply the income therefrom only for charitable and educational purposes.

The income from this trust shall be administered by a Committee of three persons, said persons being those who from time to time shall hold the following offices:

Principal of the South Hadley High School
Superintendent of Schools for South Hadley
Chairperson of the School Committee for South Hadley

These members shall serve without compensation. This Committee shall determine which applicants shall receive aid and how much, and in so doing the average boy or girl shall not be overlooked. They shall notify the Trustee of the fund, who out of income only insofar as said Trustee is able, shall make payments in such amounts as directed to the parent or legal guardian of the applicants chosen by the Committee or to the educational institution attended by said applicants, said funds to be used solely for the benefit of the applicants so chosen. Applications for aid may be made to the Committee, through parents or guardian, by an American born boy or girl between the ages of fourteen and twenty, residing in South Hadley, Massachusetts. They shall use their own judgment regarding character and qualifications of applicants, may take into consideration expenses for board, books, tuition, transportation in or out of town, instruction in vocational, manual training or trade schools or any school of a similar character. They shall aim to supplement rather than compete with the public schools in any way.

An annual report shall be made to the Town by the Trustee showing:

- 1. The amount of income received from this Fund.
- 2. The amount paid on Committee orders.
- 3. The amount of the Fund at the time the report is made.
- 4. The expense incurred by the Trustee in carrying out the provisions of this Fund.
- 5. The amount returned by students who have received aid from this Fund.

All students benefited by this Fund are expected, so far as possible, although under no legal obligation to do so, to return at some future time to the Trustee an amount equivalent to the amount received by them, thereby becoming partners in the plan, all such sums to be added to and become a part of the principal Fund.

Applications for assistance under the provisions of the Smith Educational Fund may be filed at any time with the Committee. Forms may be obtained at the Office of the Superintendent of Schools, Town Hall, 116 Main Street, South Hadley, Massachusetts.

The Committee reserves the right to make payments directly to institutions.
